




1. I enjoy school.




2. Teachers help me to do my best.




3. My teachers give me challenging work.



4. Teachers make sure we understand our work.




5. Teachers listen to me in lessons.




6. There are people in school I can talk to if I'm worried about something.




7. The behaviour of children in our school is good.



8. Teachers encourage me to be friendly to others.




9. Bullying is NOT a problem in our school.




10. I feel safe in school.




11. I know what to do if I feel unhappy or unsafe.




12. School encourages me to be healthy.
