Thank you for all of your support and donations for children in need and the mental health charity. We raised £210 for children in need and £178 to support mental health. ## Attendance

Attendance is continuing to be closely monitored with involvement from the local authority. Attendance has begun to improve, last week we achieved 95% whole school attendance year to date. Thank you for your support.

#### PE Kit

Could you please ensure that your child/children have a PE kit in school as children will be changing for PE. This must be in a drawstring PE bag and consist of:

Plain black hoody/zip up hooded top Black pumps or trainers (these must be in the PE bag and not the footwear that your child has worn to school) Black plimsolls are recommended for EYFS and KS1.



Some PE lessons do take place outside so it is advisable that your child has joggers/leggings and a hooded top/trainers in their PE bag during the colder months. PE kits will be kept in lockers in KS2.

EARRINGS CANNOT BE WORN FOR PE or SWIMMING. IF CHILDREN ARE UNABLE TO REMOVE THEIR OWN EARRINGS, PLEASE TAKE THEM OUT BEFORE SCHOOL ON PE DAYS. PE AND SWIMMING IS COMPULSARY AND PART OF THE NATIONAL CURRICULUM. YEAR 6 GO SWIMMING EVERY FRIDAY

#### Car Park

Do not walk across the car park – please stay on the paths. There are a lot of parents cutting across the car park at the moment between the cars. Please do not attempt to drive onto the car park or park in the driveway.

#### Snacks – Breaktime

Children will have free milk until their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday, children can continue to have milk after their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday, this can be paid for via coolmilk.com. EYFS/KS1 children have fruit at snacktime/breaktime. KS1 and KS2 children can pay 20p per day or £1 a week for toast or they are



welcome to bring a healthy snack from home. Packets of crisps and chocolate bars are not allowed at breaktime.



<u>Lunchtimes</u> Nursery – 11.45-12.30 Reception – 11.45-12.45 KS1 – 12.00-12.55 KS2 – 12.15-1.05

Children are allowed to bring their own drink to have with their lunch if they wish. All children must have a water bottle in school everyday for drinks throughout the day.

EYFS will be attending a theatre production for their early years Christmas outing and years 5&6 have had the opportunity to take part in a trip to the Old Rep.

#### Black Country Museum

Year one has been fortunate to take part in a pilot called Little makers. Year one had a funded visit to the Black Country Museum with a follow up visit in school to complete the project. Our children have been use
